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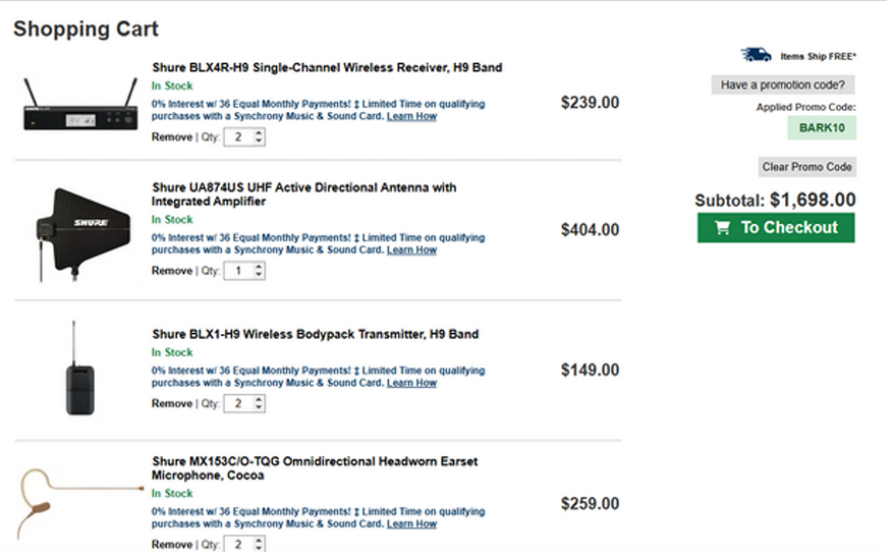

RED GYM WALL MATS TO REDUCE NOISE POLLUTION

As Youth Core Ministries, we have two programs we run on a weekly basis in our Gym and Core Life room to unchurched and low-income youth in Kiowa County. We minister to youth on Monday nights with our Core Community program, and Wednesday nights with our Core Life program. Core Community kids use our space for music and games and are ages 7-18 years. Core Life kids use our space for grades 5th-12th with games and music. This gives the youth in our county a safe place to hang out and be themselves. Games are played in our gym. It gets extremely loud when playing games such as Dodge Ball. Youth Core Ministries would like to purchase 29 pieces of red gym mats to cover 2/3rds of our North wall in our gym. This would provide additional activities for our youth, and reduce our noise pollution to our neighbors on the North side of our building. This would also impact our community in a positive way. We frequently receive noise complaints from a few of our neighbors when our Core Life kids or Core Community kids have loud music playing or are playing games such as Dodge Ball. Our hope is by placing the gym mats on our gym wall, we can reduce our noise complaints to zero. We would love to reduce our noise and be a pleasing aroma to our neighbors. We work hard to create unity with our neighbors in Greensburg.
