YMAD RESPONSIBILITIES

1. ATTEND ALL YMAD MEETINGS

- Introduction Meeting: held via Zoom in August to get to know everyone and learn how to review grant applications.
- Grant Selection Meeting: held at the end of September in Pratt.

2. READ GRANT APPLICATIONS

- Read and take notes for all grant applications before the grant selection meeting.

3. ASSIST AT COUNTY GRANT CEREMONY

- Help present awards at county grant ceremony in late October or early November.
