## **Grant Update: USD 349 Stafford County Schools**

South Central Community Foundation has been busy collecting Grant Reports from the 2019 and 2020 Grants Recipients. These grants reports help evaluate how the grant dollars were used as well as insight into the program's impact.

In 2019, USD 349 Stafford Schools received a \$1,000 from South Central Community Foundation to help support their project titled "Pay it Forward."

Pay it Forward is an initiative intended to support students and families in their efforts to get ahead by providing financial support for food resources. "This grant enabled our school to provide students and families with the kind of support they need to succeed and thrive." said Destiny Johnson, Social Worker at Stafford Schools.

This grant allowed three families, who had high dollar amounts of overdue lunch balances ranging from \$70 to \$485, to be paid off. In addition, two other families overdue lunch balances were assisted along with an anonymous donation from the community. In turn, this grant allowed a high school senior to be able to walk the stage at graduation and receive their diploma, which they previously would not have been able to do with an outstanding lunch balance.

"We are so thrilled with the impact this grant had on the students at Stafford Schools." said Holly Rooks, SCCF Executive Director, "It is such an incredible effort by USD 349 to recognize this need and seek outside resources such as SCCF to help lessen the burden for the students and their families."
