2020 GRANT CYCLE

South Central Community Foundation is excited to announce the 2020 Grant Cycle. This year SCCF is offering 3 different grant opportunities for our seven county service area. This includes Barber, Comanche, Kingman, Kiowa, Pratt, Rice, and Stafford Counties.

COMMUNITY GRANTS -- This application is available to nonprofits, schools, churches, and cities serving one or more counties in SCCF's service area. This grant is capped at \$2,000 or less and must be for tangible items.

TEACHER'S \$250 GRANT -- This grant is available to Teachers in our seven county service area for any needed classroom item. Thanks to an anonymous donor the grant funding has been raised to \$250.

NEW CHILDREN'S \$5,000 HEALTH GRANT -- This application is available to nonprofits, schools, churches, and cities serving a county in SCCF's service area. This grant is for \$5,000 and must be for a children's health project or program. Children is defined as 18 years or younger. *One recipient will be selected for each of the seven counties SCCF serves.





ESTATE PLANNING WITH JOHN GRIFFIN, STEWARDSHIP COUNSELING

Did you know that South Central Community Foundation, along with the Pratt Community College and Pratt Health Foundation, offers free estate planning to our community members and donors? There are many common mistakes in estate planning such as not having an updated plan, no durable powers of attorney / other support documents, or no business / farm transition plan in place that we want to help you avoid.

Why we do this? We believe that everyone having access to estate planning is critical. By offering this community service we allow you to save 10 hours or more of planning time with an attorney.

We contract with John Griffin, an estate planner through Stewardship Counseling, LLC . John, raised in the Netherlands and Northwest Iowa, holds a J.D. from the University of South Dakota School of Law. After practicing law in South Dakota, John joined Stewardship Counseling, LLC in 1991.
