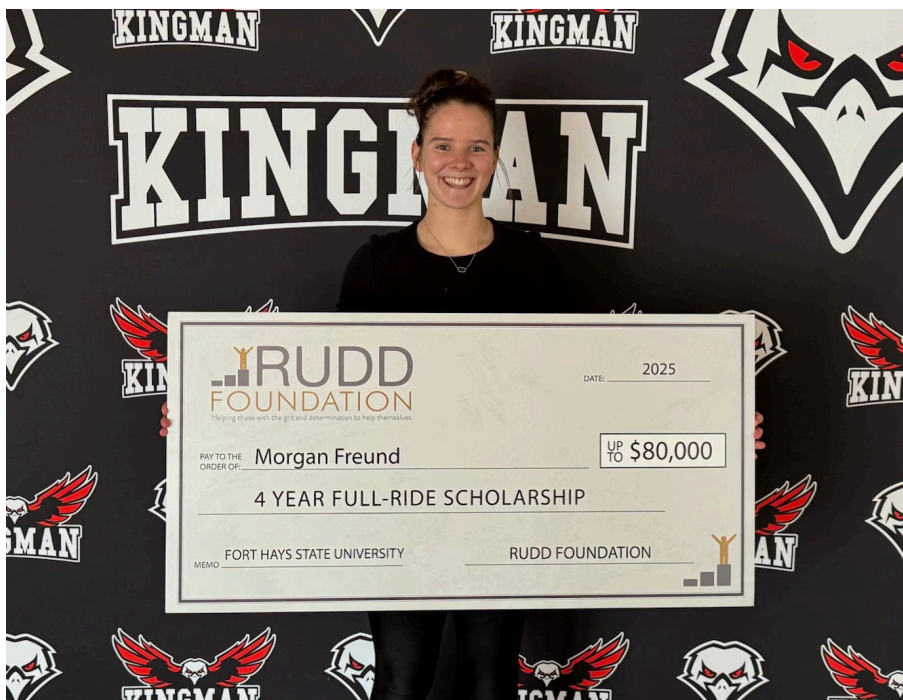


YMAD Donates 120 Water Bottle Snack Packs

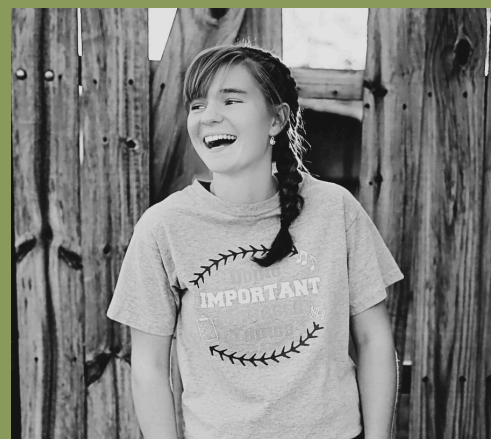
