ESTATE PLANNING WITH JOHN GRIFFIN, STEWARDSHIP COUNSELING

Did you know that South Central Community Foundation, along with the Pratt Community College and Pratt Health Foundation, offers free estate planning to our community members and donors? There are many common mistakes in estate planning such as not having an updated plan, no durable powers of attorney / other support documents, or no business / farm transition plan in place that we want to help you avoid.

Why we do this? We believe that everyone having access to estate planning is critical. By offering this community service we allow you to save 10 hours or more of planning time with an attorney.

We contract with John Griffin, an estate planner through Stewardship Counseling, LLC. John, raised in the Netherlands and Northwest Iowa, holds a J.D. from the University of South Dakota School of Law. After practicing law in South Dakota, John joined Stewardship Counseling, LLC in 1991.
